

EnCO₂re 2016 Call for Proposals – Expression of Interest

This document is intended to help you with the submission of your idea for a first-stage evaluation. Successful candidates will proceed to the next stage and will be invited to prepare a detailed proposal.

Your idea	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One idea per page. Insert a compelling narrative of no more than 150 words including the novelty vs. the state-of-the-art. • Ideas / projects led by others are also welcome, including from outside the current Climate-KIC network
Lead organization	Contact and full address of the lead partner
Potential partners and/or additional contributors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name of the other collaborating organizations and of the individuals involved. • Please note: Organizations applying for budget must be Climate-KIC partners. If they are not, please contact the enCO₂re programme management to verify if they can apply for partnership. • Supporting organizations and/or subcontractors should also be named (Climate-KIC partnership not required)
Budget required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The full cost over the entire project duration. • Note that multiannual budgets are funded in annual tranches according to a stage-gate process. Continuation of funding will be subject to positive stage gate reviews.
Expected results / impact	Briefly describe the expected results of the project at the end of 2016 and at the end of the project. Here we are interested in the results and impacts the project will achieve, not the outputs themselves.
Expected deliverables	Briefly list expected deliverables for 2016 and the rest of the project. These are the ways the results will be delivered, communicated, or demonstrated. Important: KPIs and Deliverables will be more formally defined in the subsequent proposal stage.
Dissemination and fundraising plan	The success of enCO ₂ re depends in large part on our ability to engage a wide audience in advocating for CO ₂ re-use and our ability to obtain new sources of funds to become a self-sustaining programme. Please briefly describe your competency in both communicating results and ability to tap into new funding.
Confidentiality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The one-pager will be seen by the enCO₂re Programme Management, which includes staff from Climate-KIC and Covestro. • External Experts / Reviewers may be assigned, if the appropriate checkbox are marked. • For the subsequent Full Proposal, additional provisions concerning confidentiality can be made. • All experts / reviewers have signed non-disclosure agreements. • In case of a potential conflict of interest, please contact Climate-KIC or the enCO₂re Programme Management.

What happens after I submit my idea?

The enCO₂re programme management (and in some cases, innovation experts under NDA) will evaluate your idea according to the accompanying selection criteria.

In the case of a positive first evaluation, you will receive a template to develop a full proposal. If the one-pager is not accepted, you will also be notified, with a reason for the decision. In exceptional cases, we may consult with you to modify elements as needed.

Will my idea stay confidential?

Your idea will not be submitted to anyone outside of the enCO₂re programme management and Climate-KIC. For the subsequent full proposal, additional specific confidentiality provisions can be made within the template submitted at that time. All personnel in charge with the review of your proposal will have signed Non-Disclosure-Agreements.
